What is a Columbarium?

The word "columbarium" is derived from "columba", the Latin for dovecote, a compartmented house where doves, the symbol of God's Spirit and Peace, come to roost. In modern terms, a columbarium is a consecrated structure used for the inurnment of the deceased after cremation. It is a fitting place for the remains of a Christian; a place where cremated remains of a beloved individual are treated with respect and dignity and where others can gather for quite meditation and prayer.

The Highlands Columbarium

The Columbarium is an exterior facility with ninety-six niches situated within an elegant masonry structure in the Prayer Garden. The Columbarium structure is manufactured by Matthews International. Each niche holds two solid brass urns, which are locked into place inside the niche and protected by a bronze faceplate. Attached to the faceplate is the scroll, which displays the name, date of birth, and date of death.

The Columbarium consists of ninety-six niches, located in our Prayer Garden. Your personal selection is based on availability.


Pricing includes niche and two urns. It does not include cremation, funeral arrangements or engraving.

A Help to the Family


